


**Daily Challenge: The POWER of Prayer**

When Jesus entered Capernaum, a Roman centurion came to him and asked Jesus for help. "Lord," he said, "my servant is at home and can't move. He is really hurting badly." Jesus asked, "Should I come and heal him?" But the centurion said, "Lord, I am not good enough for you to come into my house. If you will just say the word, my servant will be healed. I know you have the power and authority to make it happen just by speaking the words. When Jesus heard this, he was amazed. He said to the people who had been following him, "What I'm about to tell you is true. In all of Israel I have not found anyone whose faith is so strong." Then Jesus said to the Roman centurion, "Go! It will be done just as you believed it would." And the centurion's servant was healed right at that moment!
