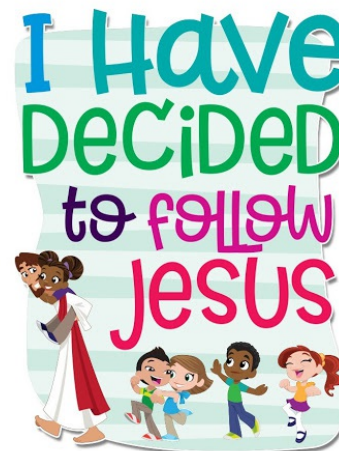

LEARN IT!

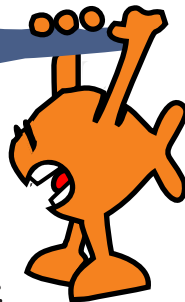
